THE PAGES OF THESE GREAT NOVELS ARE FILLED WITH DISAFFECTED FANATICS, INSTITUTIONAL DECAY, AND MORAL QUANDARIES THAT ARE REMARKABLY FAMILIAR AND VEXING TO US NOW. INDEED, WE HAVE MUCH MORE IN COMMON WITH THIS DISTANT MIRROR THAN WE MIGHT THINK. TO MAKE THE 19TH RUSSIAN CENTURY NOVEL RELEVANT FOR CITIZENS AND THINKERS OF THE 21ST, OUR COURSE WILL EXAMINE THE AFTERLIVES OF RUSSIAN LITERATURE IN CONTEMPORARY CINEMA.
